

#### Dream Mapping for Adults

In this workshop we will explore the idea of Dream Cartography - creating a map of our own dreamworld. Often in dreams we find ourselves inhabiting a personal dream-realm which seems to encode our history and psyche into the very fabric of the archaeological structures, stations, watery habitats, geological features, human and animal forms incorporated into it. Dream mapping can reveal a lot about our own inner workings; our recurring themes and motifs, and the nature of dreaming itself.

The Curious Kids Festival takeover is an immersive, child centric day which aims to provide young people with a diverse programme of "curiously creative" activities run by experienced local artists.

Each child will be given a Curiosity Passport on entry to prompt them to explore the space, take part in all the activities on offer and create their own collection of festival memorabilia to take home.

The festival will be split into two sessions from 10-1pm and then from 2-5pm, so that families can have the opportunity to explore as many of the activities as possible.



ZEROH are local artists who work across a number of disciplines to create public facing artworks.

Zeroh will be engaging participants to create a moth using markings based on native species, inspired by colour and patterns, which will then be digitised and added to an animated installation to be exhibited in the OB on Saturday June 3rd.



Lou makes large, 3D structures, tiny automata, and lots more in between - all in cardboard, a resource she feels is totally underrated.

This workshop is collage based, finding, and creating funny people using a mixture of body parts and other strange objects that have been collected. For this workshop the participants will be cutting out and making jointed little people with collage, cardboard, glue, and split pins.



Anna runs myth and fairytale-based art workshops exploring metaphor through story for both adults and children.

In this workshop children will be invited to create their own mini jam jar diorama based on Victorian curiosity cabinets. Using miniature toy figures, old doll house pieces, recycled rubbish, natural materials and playdough, children can create their own mini universe, figure or scene. A moment frozen in time in 3-D materials, to be taken home and treasured.



Janey Moffatt fuses fine art with craft techniques for her work at The Craftimation Factory, bringing art activities to everyone, especially those who face barriers.

Eye Spy! Design a giant eye inspired badge from black card and neon UV paper, shape punch cutters, scissors and plenty of imagination. You can wear it and hang it up at home when you're done.



Have fun using drawing machines and create your own giant structures!

Marie-Louise Miller leads creative play and imaginative problem solving for curious minds of all ages. Creating large-scale immersive 3D drawing, drawing machines and superstructures using strong but lightweight paper stixx made from recycled newspaper and secured with ties.



Makedo is a series of safe cardboard construction tools purposely designed for kids to imagine and build the world they want to see. Using a simple cardboard box kids can create their own curious creatures or objects during this freeform activity that will help spark their imagination and highlight the potential and value of this humble, everyday material. This workshop will be run by young creative facilitators currently studying at college.

Each child will be invited to screen print their own, personalised festival T-shirt, based on the theme of CURIOSITY and using an array of stencils, stamps and fluorescent inks. The kids can then explore the "curious space installation" using 2D shapes and UV light to allow them to see their artwork in a different light.

A creative children's company run by partners Clare Tomlinson and Andrew Davies who utilise their design backgrounds to create unique interactive products for kids. Over the last 15 years they have been running print workshops in galleries, schools and at festivals to share their passion for print.


#### Cabaret Afterparty at Printworks

Building up the 3D shape takes time and is a very relaxing and meditative practice which is very addictive!




#### Naomi Wood Aertal Hoop


